Deep bass, crystal clear treble and a wide middle section.

- The touch is very responsive and controllable, similar to that of a concert piano.
- The unique pedal design allows for especially quiet pedaling and is virtually maintenance-free.
- Of all the instruments tested it was the one with the richest sound; ranging from an extremely fine pianissimo to a full and powerful fortissimo.
